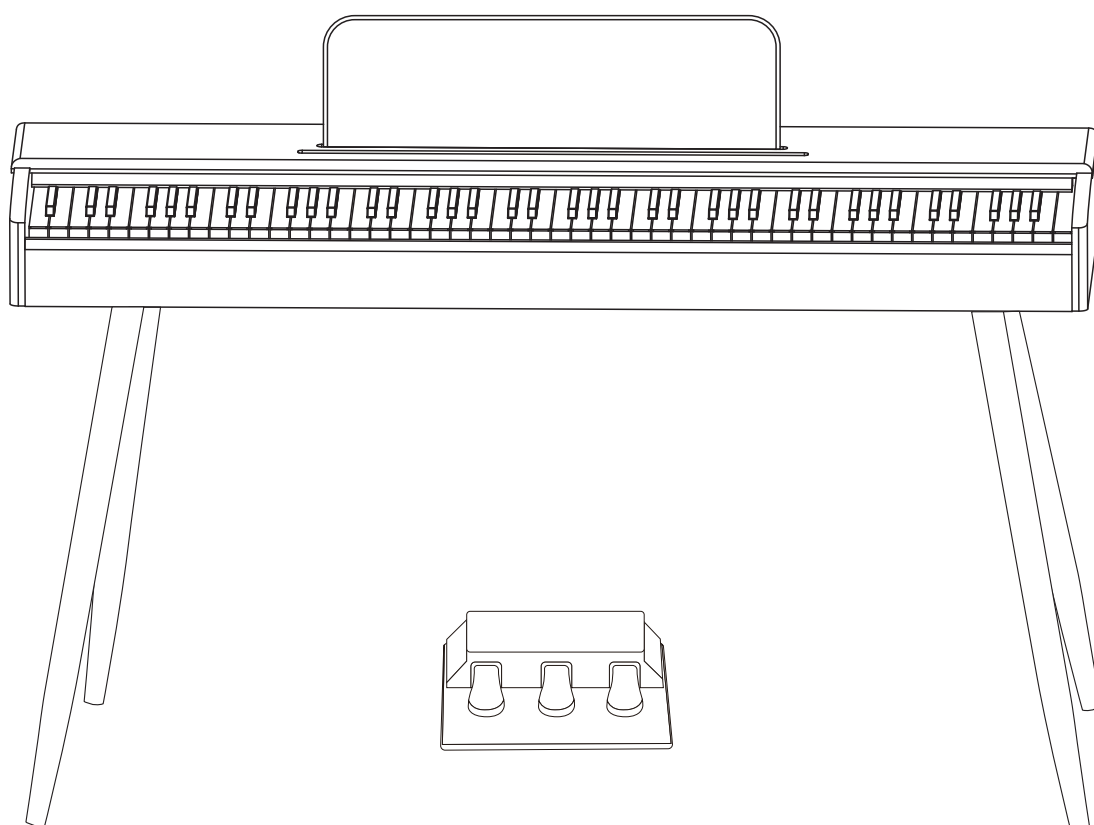

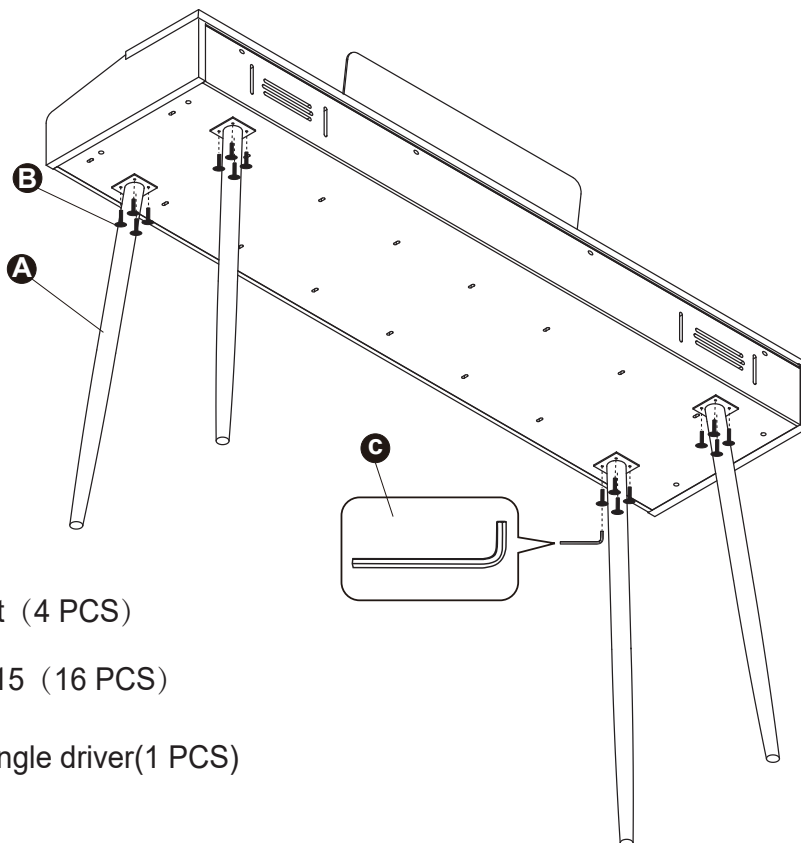
## REMARKS !

- The installation diagram provided is solely applicable to the wooden underframe version. Please refer to the respective installation diagrams for other types of underframes.

## INSTALLATION OF WOODEN TRIPOD:

- Firstly, lock the bottom frame screws according to the direction of the arrow.
- Next, place the digital piano on the bottom frame and lock the fixing screw.
- Finally, insert the music score frame into the card slot.

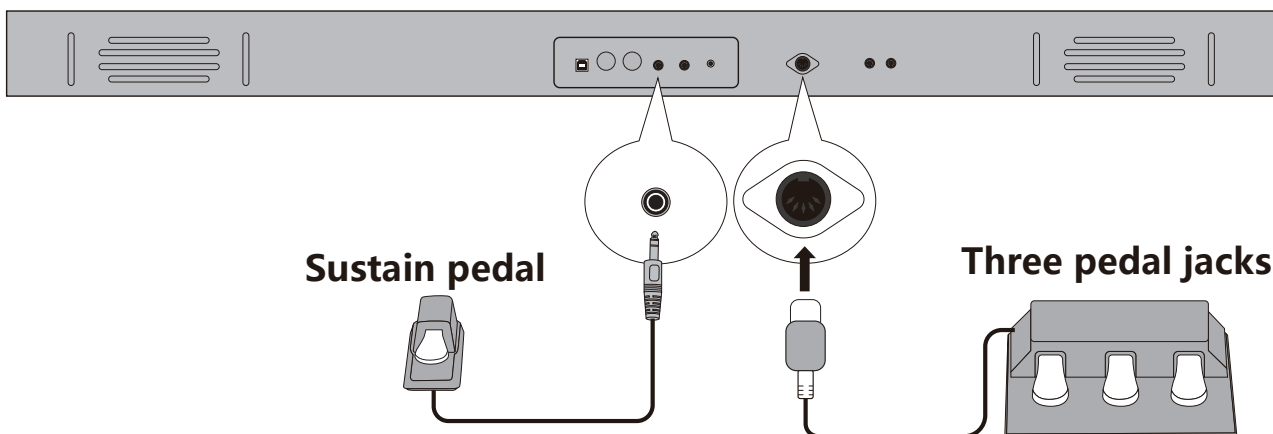


- A** Iron bracket (4 PCS)

## Placing the pedal and inserting the connection cable

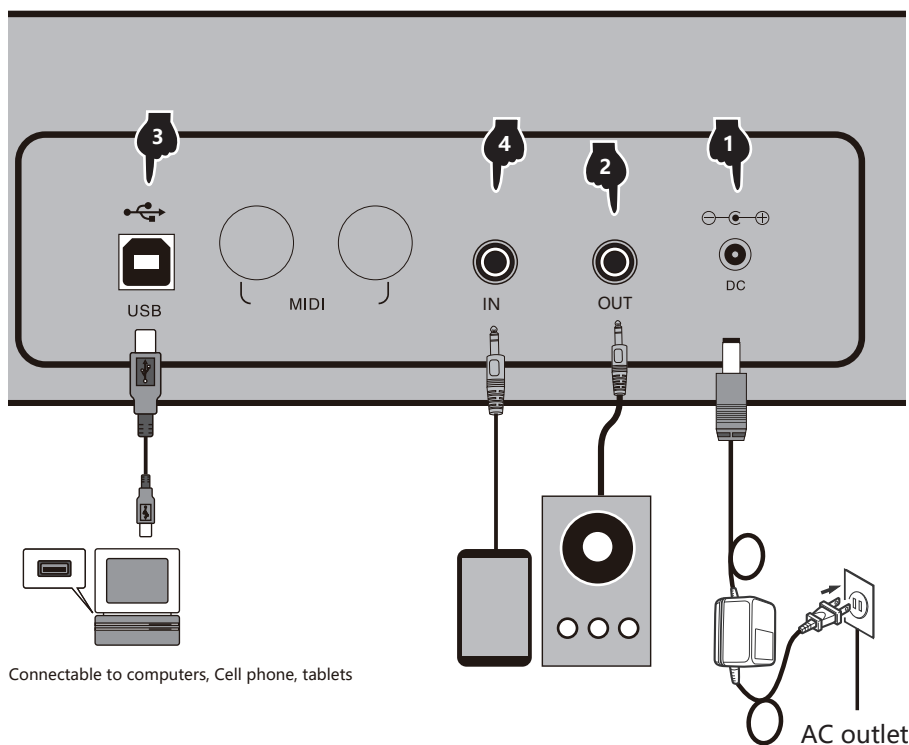
- Please insert the connection cable in place to avoid poor contact and insert it correctly as shown in the diagram.

### Socket Panel



#### 1 Power cord connection

1. Plug in the power cord as shown in the diagram, one end into the power port of the drum box, and the other end into a 100-240V household power outlet (Figure 1)
2. When the product is not used for a long time, please unplug the power cord and store it properly.

#### 2 OUT

Can be connected to audio, speakers, amplifiers, etc. (Figure 2)

#### 3 USB transmission interface

Use the USB transfer interface of this digital piano to connect to your computer. Through the music software pre-installed on the computer, you can learn or play the keyboard to perform, compose, store and other functional operations. The edited music and the built-in accompaniment of the music software can be connected to the digital piano through the software for playing or performing according to the accompaniment music. #### 4 IN

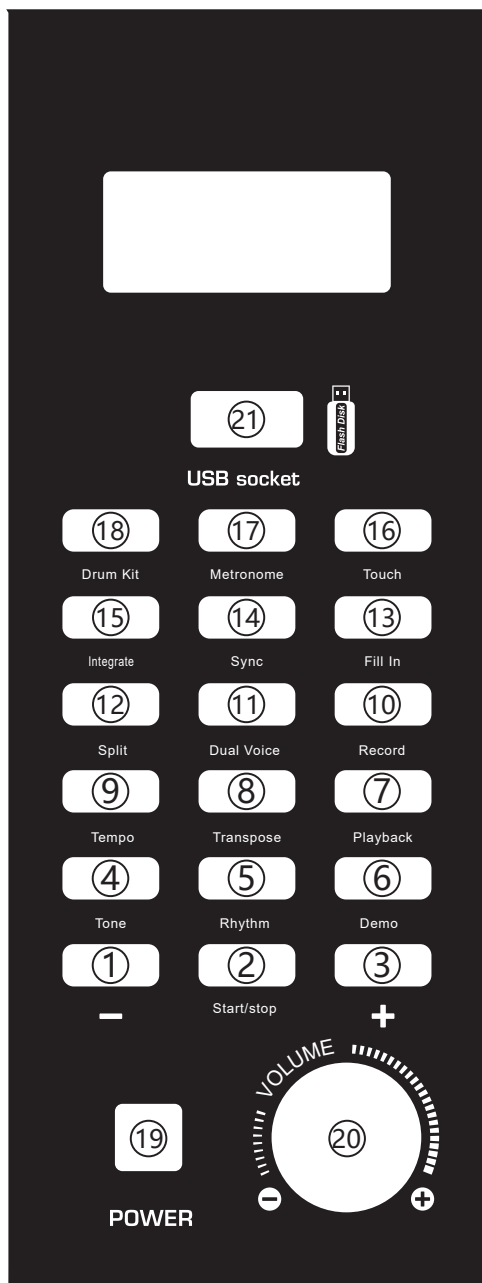
The audio input socket connects the external sound source to the electric piano for playback. (Figure 2)

#### 5 Bluetooth MIDI

Ability to play games, MP3 songs, etc. via Bluetooth MIDI connection to APP (optional)



# Operation Guide



## 1 On/Off

Press the <Power> button to turn on the volume power, and press it again to turn it off. (Figure 19)

## 2 Volume

Turn the <Volume> knob to adjust the volume level. (Figure 20)

## 3 Tone selection

1. Find the timbre you need in the timbre table and remember its timbre number
2. Press the Tone button to enter Tone mode. (Figure 4)
3. Select the desired tone by selecting the "+" "-" keys, the tone numbers are (000-127). (Figure 1~Figure 3)

## 4 Rhythm selection

1. Press the rhythm key to enter the rhythm mode. (Figure 5)
2. Select the desired rhythm by choosing the "+" "-" keys, the rhythm number is (000-127). (Figure 1~Figure 3)
3. Press the "Start/Stop" key to start playing the rhythm. (Figure 2)
4. Press "Start/Stop" again to stop playback. (Figure 2)

## 5 Demonstration song selection

1. Press the Demo button to enter the Demo Song mode. (Figure 6)
2. Select the desired demonstration tune by choosing the "+" "-" keys with the rhythm numbers (000-029) (Figure 1~Figure 3).
3. Press "Start/Stop" to start playing the demo song. (Figure 2)
4. Press "Start/Stop" again to stop playback. (Figure 2)

## 6 Drum Kit

1. Press the "Drum Kit" key to enter the keyboard drum mode, the keyboard changes to percussion.
2. Press the "Drum Kit" key again to exit this mode. (Figure 18)

## 7 Metronome

1. Press the "Metronome" button to start playing the metronome.
2. Long press the "Metronome" key, and then press the "+" and "-" keys to switch the metronome type. (Figure 1~Figure 3)
3. Press "Metronome" again to turn off the metronome.

## 8 Touch

1. Press the "Touch" button several times to select different strength modes. (Figure 16)
2. When the screen shows "off", the intensity is turned off and the keys have no intensity.

## 9 Integrate

1. Press the "Integrate" key to open the left chord keyboard. (Figure 15)
2. Press the "Integrate" button again to close the composite chord.



# Operatio Guide

## 10 Sync

1. With the chord on, press the "Sync" button to turn on the synchronization function. (Figure 14)
2. Play the left hand chord area chord at this point and the accompaniment changes back to start playing automatically.

## 11 Fill In

Press "Fill In" in the rhythm playback status to start playing the inserted rhythm. (Figure 13)

## 12 Split

1. Use the dual keyboard to assign two different tones to the two ends of the keyboard, so you can play one tone with your left hand and another tone with your right hand.
2. Select a tone as the primary tone and press the "Split" key to enter the dual keyboard mode.
3. Then switch the tones and select one as the second tone.
4. Press the "Split" key again to exit the dual keyboard mode. (Figure 12)

## 13 Dual Voice

1. First enter the tone mode, select an instrument as the main tone.
2. Then press the "Dual Voice" button to enter the second tone selection mode. (Figure 11)
3. Use the "+" and "-" keys to select another instrument as the second tone. (Figure 1~Figure 3)
4. The effect of playing this time is that the two tones blend together.

## 14 Record/Playback

1. Press the "Record" button to enter the recording mode. (Figure 10)
2. At this time, play the keyboard to start recording.
3. After playing, press "Playback" key to start playing back the recording. (Figure 7)

## 15 Tempo

1. Press the "tempo" button to enter the speed adjustment interface. (Figure 9)
2. Then press the "+" "-" key to adjust the speed. (Figure 1~Figure 3)
3. Speed range is: 30-300

## 16 Transpose

1. Press the "Transpose" key to enter the shift interface. (Figure 8)
2. Then press "+" "-" key to change the key. (Figure 1~Figure 3)
3. Shift range is:  $\pm 12$

## 17 MP3 Players

1. insert the downloaded songs U disk, a few seconds after the piano play U disk songs, U disk inserted state, press the "start / stop" key can pause and continue to play MP3. (Figure 21 ~ Figure 2)
2. short press the "+" key to play the next song, long press the "+" key to add volume. (Figure 1 ~ Figure 3)
3. short press "-" key to play the previous song, long press "-" key for the volume keys. (Figure 1~Figure 3)

## PRODUCT MAINTENANCE

Careful maintenance and protection of this product play an important role in prolonging the the service life of the product and reducing the failure.

### **1 AVOID HEATING, DAMPNES, OR DIRECT SUNLIGHT**

Do not over-expose the product to direct sunlight, or place it near air conditioning or extremely hot place.

### **2 DO NOT USE NEAR THE TV OR RADIO**

This product may cause video or audio interference to the reception of TV and radio. If this happens, the product should be removed from the TV or radio.

### **3 NO DILUENTS OR SIMILAR CHEMICALS SHOULD BE USED FOR CLEANING**

Clean the product with a soft cloth wetted with weak water solution and neutral detergent. Soak the cloth in a solution and wring it dry until it approaches drying.

### **4 DO NOT SHAKE, AVOID COLLISION**

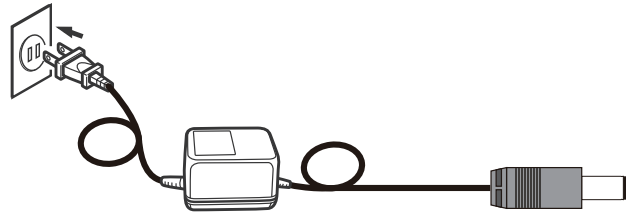
When moving, the product should be handled carefully and lightly. Violent vibration and collision are strictly prohibited to avoid damage to the shell or internal electronic components.

### POWER SUPPLY

This product can be powered by a standard indoor wall socket. Please only use the power cord equipped with this product. Be sure to turn off the power when not in use temporarily. When not in use for a long time, please unplug the power cord and keep it properly.



### SIGN

To ensure that you use this product safely and correctly, to prevent harm to users and others and financial damage, this manual and products are marked with a series of safety signs. The various signs and their meanings are as follows:

## WARNING




### Smoke, odor, overheating

### Power cord
