

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Before using, please read this user manual carefully and keep it for future reference.

Danger Warning

- To avoid electric shock and/or fire hazard, do not allow water, liquid or any flammable detergent to get into or to clean the appliance.
- 2. Do not spray any flammable materials such as pesticides or perfumes around the appliance.

Safety Warning

- Before connecting the power supply, please check whether the voltage of the appliance corresponds
 to the local power supply voltage.
- 2. If power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by qualified personnel in order to avoid hazard.
- 3. Do not use the appliance if the adaptor, the power cord or the appliance is damaged.
- 4. Do not block the air inlet and outlet.
- 5. Make sure that foreign objects do not fall into the appliance through the air outlet.
- Person with physical or mental disability, or lack of experiences and kenowledge (including children) should use the product under supervision or instruction concerning use of the machine given by a person responsible for their safety.


Caution

- This appliance is not a substitute for proper ventilation, regular vacuum cleaning, or use of an extractor hood or fan while cooking.
- 2. Ensure the appliance socket is well connected with plug. If not, the plug will become hot.
- 3. Do not sit or stand on the appliance. Do not place anything on top of the appliance.


- 4. Always place and use the appliance on a dry, stable, and horizontal surface.
- 5. Leave at least 30cm space on the back and sides of the appliance, and at least 50cm space above the appliance when it is in use.
- 6. Do not place the appliance directly below an air conditioner to prevent condensation from dripping onto the appliance.
- 7. Ensure both the filter and the back cover are properly installed before connectting to power.
- Only use the original RASLOK H13 HEPA filters intended for this appliance. Do not use any other filters.
- 9. Do not take the filter as fuel or similar purposes to avoid irreversible harm.
- 10. Do not use hard objects to strike the appliance, especially the air outlet and air inlet.
- 11. Do not insert finger or other objects into the air outlet or the air inlet to prevent physical injury or malfunction of the appliance.
- 12. Do not use this appliance when you are using an indoor spray repellent, or in a place filled with grease, flammable gas or chemical fumes.
- 13. Always turn off the air purifier first, then unplug the adapter, when you need to move, clean the appliance, replace the filters or carry out other maintenance.
- 14. Unplug the power cable before moving the appliance.

USING THE AIR PURIFIER

Air Quality Light

The air quality light automatically goes on when the air purifier is switched on, and lights up all colors in sequence. In a short time the air quality sensors select the color that corresponds to the ambient air quality.

PM2.5 Level	Air Quality Light Color	Air Quality Level
≤75	Blue	Good
75-150	Yellow	Fair
>150	Red	Poor

Before Use

Remove all packaging of the filter before use. Ensure the air purifier is unplugged from the electric outlet before removing or installing the filter.













- 1. Press the red circle switch to take out the back cover.
- 2. Remove the filter from the machine.
- 3. Remove the packaging of the new filter.
- 4. Put the filter into the machine.
- 5. Press the red circle switch button to close the back cover.

Button Operation

Connect the power, all indicators will be on for one time and all lights will be off except the power button. After that, the appliance will be in standby mode.

Power Button

Press the power button to switch on and switch off the air purifier. The air purifier operates in the auto mode by default. After measuring the air quality for a short time, the air quality sensor automatically selects the color of the air quality light.

Note: After the air purifier is switched off by the power button, if the plug is still in the power socket, the air purifier will operate under the previous settings when it is switched on again.

Mode Switch / Filter Reset Button

You can choose Auto mode, High mode or Sleep mode by pressing the mode switch button. In Auto mode, the air purifier selects the fan speed in accordance with the ambient air quality. In High mode, the air purifier operates on the highest speed.

In Sleep mode, the air purifier operates quietly at a low speed.

Reminder of Replacing Filter

When the air purifier detects that the filter reaches its lifespan for use, the filter replacement alert light flashes in red, which indicates that it needs to be replaced.

After replacing the new filter, you need to press the filter reset button for about 7 seconds to reset the filter lifetime counter.

UV / Anion / Light Button

You can adjust the brightness of air quality light by pressing the light button.

Press the button for 3 seconds to turn on and off the UV and Anion, the corresponding indicator light will be on.

Note: When the UV is turned on, it will run in automatic mode, then turn on for every 2 hours and turn off for every 2 hours.

Timer / WiFi Button

With the timer, you can let the air purifier operate for a set number of hours. When the set time has elapsed, the air purifer will automatically switch off.

Press the timer button repeatedly to choose the number of hours you want the air purifier to operate.

The timer is available in 2, 4 or 8 hours.

Press the button for 5 seconds to set up and reset the WiFi connection.

WORKS WITH SMART LIFE APP

Download & Registration

1. Scan the QR code to download "Smart Life" APP. You can also search "Smart Life" in App Store or Google Play to instill the APP. Open the "Smart Life" APP. Tap "Register" to register a "Smart Life" account with your phone number or E-mail. Then sign in the APP.



Add Devices in Easy Mode (Recommend)

- 1. Make sure your air purifier is energized and your mobile phone is connected to your WiFi network. If the WiFi indicator of air purifier keeps flashing to indicate that the air purifier enters the mode of configuring the mobile phone; if not, please press the Timer button for more than 5 seconds, after hearing the air purifier "beep", then release it and this means the device is already for configuration.
- 2. Open your "Smart Life" APP and tap "+" on the top right of the APP. Select type of service device, tap "All devices" and turn to" Add Device", then automatically fetch the password of the WiFi network that your mobile phone connects to. Then tap "OK" to connect to the device.
- When appearing "Successfully added 1 device", it means the connection is complete and your device will be listed in your APP list.

Add Devices in AP Mode

- 1. If failed in Easy Mode, users could also add devices in AP Mode.
- 2. Press the Timer button for more than 5 seconds until hearing "beep" and the WiFi indicator light begin to flash quickly, then press the Timer button for another 5 seconds until haring "beep" and the indicator light begin flash slowly, this means the device is already for configuration in the AP Mode.
- 3. Tap "+" on the top right of the APP. Select "Device Type" and tap it. Then select "AP Mode" on the top right of the APP. Tap "Connect now" to go to the WLAN Settings interface in your mobile phone and select the WiFi network named "Smart Life XXXX" to connect it.
- 4. Return to the "Smart Life" APP, the connection will start automatically.
- When appears "Successully added 1 device", it means the connection is complete and your device will be listed in your APP list.

Now you can control your smart device via your mobile phone APP anytime and anywhere (Make sure your mobile phone and smart device are all connected to the network, and to change the router name into Smart Life XXXX).

MAINTENANCE

Replacing the filter

When the filter replacement alert lights up in red, it indicates that the filter needs to be replaced. Please use the filter specially designed for this product.

- 1. Take out the expired air purification filter and gently put it into the trash bin.
- 2. Remove all packaging material of the new filter.
- 3. Place the new filter back into the machine.
- 4. Press and hold the filter reset button for 7 seconds to reset the filter lifetime counter.
- 5. Wash your hands thoroughly after replacing the filter.

Note:

- · Clean the filter regularly. Do not wash or reuse the filter.
- · Always turn off the air purifier and unplug from the electric outlet before replacing the filter.
- . Do not use a vacuum cleaner to clean the filter or wash it directly.
- Do not touch or smell the used filter as it has collected pollutants from the air.

You can replace the filter even before filter replacement alert displays on the screen. After replacing a filter, you need to reset the filter lifetime counter manually.

Cleaning & Storage

Note:

- · Ensure the machine is unplugged before maintenance.
- · Do not immerse the air purifier into water or any other liquid.
- Do not use abrasive, corrosive or flammable cleansers (such as bleach or alcohol) to clean any part of the machine.
- . The air purification filter is not washable nor vacuum cleanable.

Regularly clean the inside and outside of the machine

Wipe away dust with a soft dry cloth from the body and air outlet of the air purifier.

Take out the filter to clean any dust from the surface of it.

If you do not use the machine for a long time, ensure the machine is dry out, put on the dust cover bag and place it in a cool and well-ventilated place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This chapter summarizes the most common problems you could encounter with the machine.

If you are unable to solve the problem with the information below, contact the Customer Care Center.

Problem	Possbile Solution
The machine does not work even though it is plugged in.	The filter replacement alert is on but you have not replaced the filter yet. The air purifier will be locked if you keep using the expired filter. In this case, replace the filter and reset the filter lifetime counter.
The airflow that comes out of the air outlet is significantly weaker than before.	The surface of the filter is dirty. Clean the surface of the filter.
The air quality does not improve, even though the machine has been operating for a long time.	 Check if the packing material is removed from the filter. Make sure that the filter is properly installed. The air quality sensor is dirty or wet. Clean the air quality sensor. Room size is large or the outdoor air quality is poor. For optimal purification performance, please close the doors and windows when operating the air purifier. There are indoor pollution resources. For instances, smoking, cooking, incense. Filter reaches the end of life. Replace the filter with a new one.

Problem	Possible solution
The machine produces a strange smell.	The first few times you use the machine, it may produce a plastic smell. This is normal. However, if the machine produces a burnt smell even if removing the filter, contact your RASLOK dealer or RASLOK Customer Care Center. The filter may produce smell after being used for a while because of the absorption of indoor gases. It's recommended that you reactivate the filter by putting it in direct sunlight for repeated use. If odour still exists, replace the filter.
The machine is extra loud.	Check if the packing materials of the filter are removed. The appliance will run in high speed when the air quality is poor, which will cause higher noises. When using the appliance in a bedroom at night, choose the Sleep speed. If anything drops into air outlet, it may also cause abnormal loud sounds. Immediately turn off machine, turn machine upside down, to get foreign objects out of the machine.
The appliance still indicates that I need to replace a filter, but I already did.	Perhaps you did not reset the filter lifetime counter. Switch on the air purifier. Then press and hold the mode switch button for 7 seconds until the filter replacement alert disappears.
