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1.Click " Meal Plan"

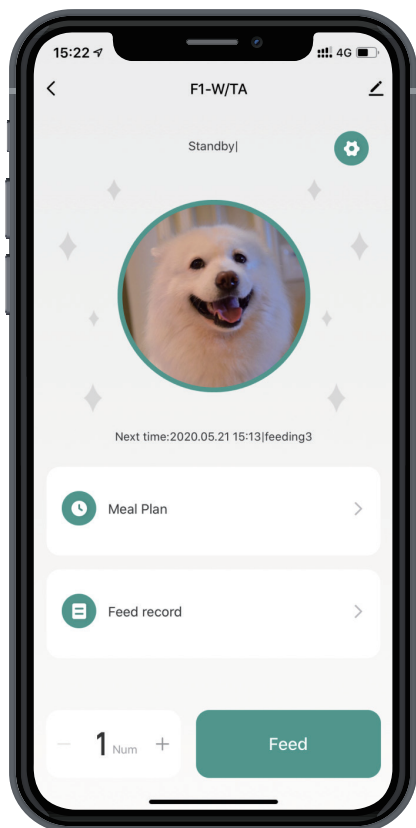
2.Click "+" to add a feeding schedule.

Please refer to the Portion Chart to choose your desired number of portions.

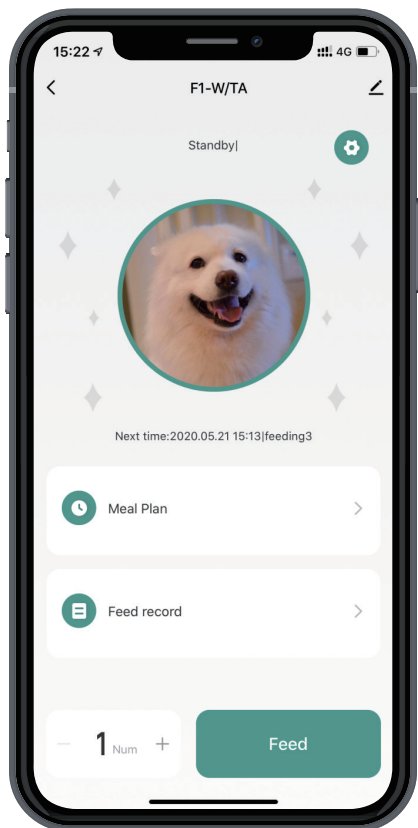
3.To delete a meal setting, slide to the left and click "Delete."



## Feed Manually

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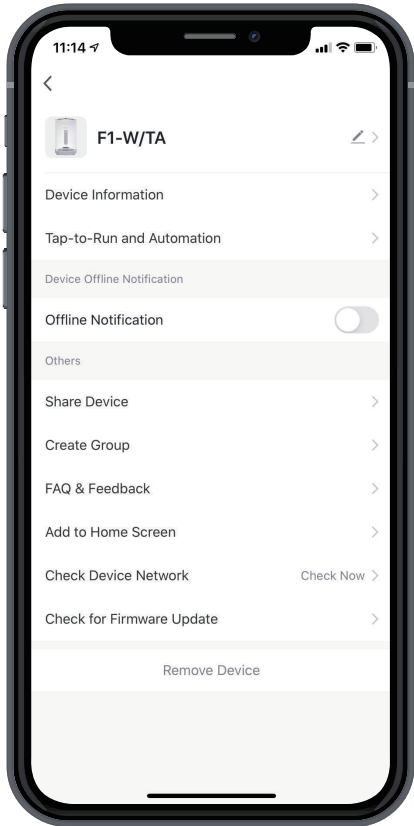
1. Quick press "Feed" to dispense a single portion of food.

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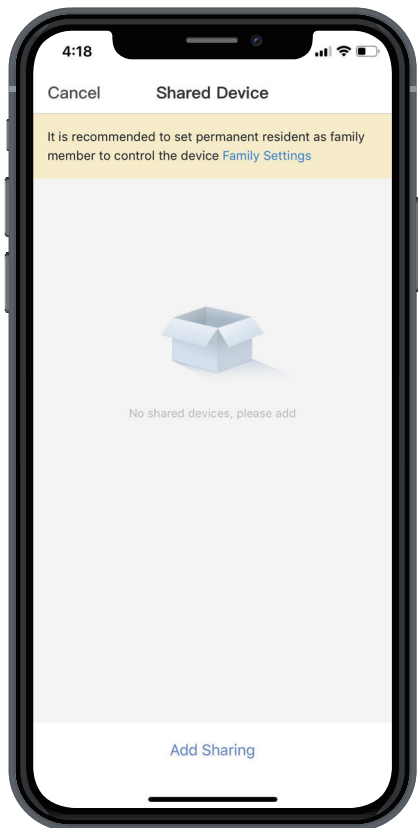
You can click " " to check the firmware updates and modify the device name, also remove device as well.



## Shared Device

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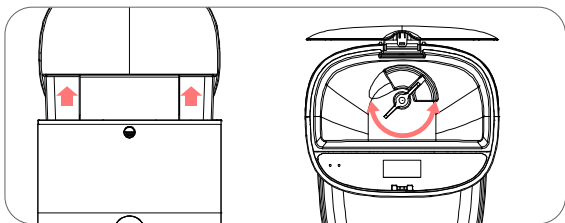

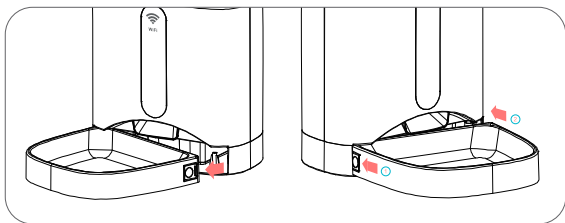
## Assemble & Disassemble

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1.To assemble, align food bucket with slots in the main body and press down.



2.To disassemble, hold both sides of the food bucket and lift upwards.



### **⚠** Cleaning Your Smart Feeder

1. Please cut off and unplug the device before cleaning.
  2. Clean the unit with a damp cloth rather than a soaked cloth.
  3. The food tray and tank can be removed for cleaning in the automatic dishwasher.
  4. The base can't be immersed in water at any time, or it may cause short-circuit of the device.
  5. It needs to be wiped clean and completely dry before refilling the food.

  - ★ Do NOT place anything on top of the pet feeder. The unit starts automatically.
  - ★ Do NOT disassemble the pet feeder other than components as instructed in this operating guide.
  - ★ Do NOT install or store pet feeder where it will be exposed to weather or temperatures below -20°C.
  - ★ Do NOT immerse control panel in water. Base should NOT be submerged in water at any time, as this may damage electronic components.
  - ★ Do NOT use this pet feeder with puppies, kittens, dogs or cats not able to reach the food tray or with any physical disability.
  - ★ Do NOT operate any appliance if it has a damaged power cord or plug, or if malfunction or has been damaged. Call the Customer Care Center immediately for further instructions.
  - ★ Do NOT allow pets to chew on or swallow any parts. If you are concerned about the power cord, purchase a cord conduit (a hard plastic protector) in to protect the power cord.
  - ★ Do NOT attempt to repair the pet feeder by yourself.

## Important Safety Information

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- ★ If an extension cord is necessary, an extension cord with a proper rating should be used.
- ★ Do NOT use pet feeder for anything other than intended use. Using attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause an unsafe condition.
- ★ Do NOT lift pet feeder by lid, hopper, bowl or bowl holder. Lift and carry feeder using both hands and hopper base, while keeping unit in upright position.
- ★ For dry food only. DO NOT use wet, canned or moist food.
- ★ To avoid tripping, always position power cord out of the way of foot traffic.
- ★ If the plug of this device gets wet, turn off the electricity to that wall outlet. Do not attempt to unplug.
- ★ Examine this appliance after installation. Do not plug in if there is water on the Power Cord or plug.
